
## What's Been Happening?

This year we have reduced the minimum age to 55 so if you would like to join us please come along and give it a try. There is no need to book - just turn up!



#### **Development Update**

A brief update on some of the developments in Flitwick:

#### **Market Town Regeneration Project**

The public realm improvements in the town centre around Kings Road/Station Road/ High Street/The Avenue are continuing to take shape.

The road closure of Kings Road is scheduled to remain in place until Friday 20th **March** to install and cure the blockwork.

On **Sunday 15th March** both Kings Road and Station Road will be closed for surfacing works and changes to the island.

Works in The Avenue are due to commence shortly.

#### What Do They Do?

#### Local mum supports breastfeeding campaign to help families feel #FreeToFeed in Flitwick

Flitwick mum Kayleigh Hancock is championing the rights of mothers to breastfeed their children in public by supporting a local campaign, #FreeToFeed. The campaign, which aims to normalise breastfeeding and raise awareness of its benefits, is run by Bedfordshire NHS and local authorities, and has already gathered support from nearly 120 businesses



and venues so far. These campaign partners are openly promoting breastfeeding with stickers, posters, taking a "breastfeeding pledge" and listing themselves on the Breastfeeding Hub App, to help mums feel confident and comfortable breastfeeding when out and about.

Kayleigh has been active in supporting the campaign since it launched in 2019,

starring in its launch film and posters, speaking to Bedford Radio, and even featuring in an ITV Anglia news report about why she feels it's important. She's also recruited a range of Flitwick's businesses and venues to join the cause.

"I used to feel a bit nervous or shy when breastfeeding, so I know how important it is for mums to feel welcome and safe when they're feeding their little ones", said Kayleigh. "Breastfeeding makes me feel amazing, and is great for my little boy, but it can be difficult. We should do everything we can to make it easier for mums - that's what #FreeToFeed is all about."



#### **Get Involved**

Signing up to the campaign is a great opportunity for businesses and venues to demonstrate their family-friendly credentials. It's also a chance to make sure that staff understand and comply with the Equality Act 2010, which states that women have the right to breastfeed in public without being refused service or discriminated against in any way.
