Open Forum

3 residents wished to raise their concerns with planning application 20/00483. Residents shared the same opinion and wished to express concern around the parking issues that already exist within Larkway and felt that an additional dwelling would only add to this.

Concern was raised by one resident that the proposed dwelling would cause his property to become overlooked. Another resident wished to advised Members that the new proposed fence line would cause blocked vision when pulling off their driveway. Residents added that the tree that had been removed provided good homes for birds and natural habitat.

Rev'd Lucy Davis advised Members that Saint Andrews Church Hall was no longer fit for purpose and would cost an enormous amount to rebuild, therefore the decision had been made to sell the land as the Hall could not be left as It was. Members were advised that their was a statutory obligation to look after the current St Peter & St Pauls bullding and in order to maximise income from the land it was hoping to be sold with planning permission. Rev'd Lucy Davis asked the Town Council to support the application based on this.
