(FLITWICK: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 15)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

Notice is hereby given that Central Bedfordshire Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Footpath No 15, Flitwick which extends from its junction with Astwood Drive at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0283 3570 (Map point A) in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 234 metres to OS GR TL 0269 3589 (Map point B)

This temporary closure is required to enable a new bridge to be installed where the footpath crosses the ditch. The closure is expected to take place from Monday 23rd November for up to three weeks.

The alternative route for pedestrians while the closure is in operation is via the pavements through the new estate, Steppingley and Windmill Road and Millwright Way.

The Order will come into operation on 23 November 2020 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
