#### a. <u>Refrigerator Purchase</u>

### c. <u>Tenant EV Charging Point</u>

Members are asked to consider agreement for a tenant to install an EV charger point for their car park space which will have a metered supply and be paid for by the tenant.

### d. <u>Electric Vehicle Charge points across Central Bedfordshire</u>

Central Bedfordshire Council will shortly be seeking to procure commercial charge point providers with respect to their own carparks and buildings and on-street residential charging. They are keen to work with Town and Parish council's where possible, to include

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their carparks and buildings within the scope of the contracts. CBC see this as being the best way for EV Charge points to be installed in key areas across Central Bedfordshire in a way that minimises both risk and financial outlay, whilst at the same time also limits the future burden of managing and maintaining this infrastructure.

The contractual basis for the agreement will be confirmed through the procurement process. However, based on what has been done elsewhere this will see the provider effectively leasing parking spaces to provide the EV charging points.

Members are asked to approve putting forward two parking spaces at the Rufus Centre as part of this proposed scheme.
