Flitwick Town Council (FTC) is a third tier local Government organisation made up of four departments in the staff team – corporate, business, environmental and community. We proactively work on aims set within our strategy and focus on exceptional service provision whilst owning and managing The Rufus Centre, a busy meetings, conference and events centre where the Town Council offices are based.

Another string to our bow is our relatively new Rendezvous Café & Bar at The Rufus Centre which has grown from strength to strength since opening in August 2020.

There are 17 elected Members of the Council who volunteer their time to represent the residents of Flitwick and make key decisions for the community. Our Members have expertise in a range of areas, such as finance, business and the arts, which helps the staff team with their tasks. Since the last election in 2019, Members have decided to change many things, such as increased community engagement and becoming more strategic, which has positively impacted the direction of the Council.

Working for FTC has many benefits including automatic enrolment to a generous pension scheme, an attractive annual leave allocation and staff discount for the Café. The Council has a dedicated Personnel Committee made up of Members who ensure that the duty of care towards staff is upheld.
