Flitwick Town Council (FTC) is a third tier local Government organisation made up of four departments in the staff team – corporate, business, environmental and community. We proactively work on aims set within our strategy and focus on exceptional service provision whilst owning and managing the Rufus Centre, a conferencing and events centre. Another string to our bow is our relatively new Rendezvous Café which is going from strength to strength after just 18 months of being open.

There are 17 elected Members of the Council who volunteer their time to represent their residents and make key decisions for the community. Our Members have expertise in a range of areas, such as finance, business and the arts, which helps the staff team with their tasks. Since the last election in 2019, Members have decided to change many things, such as increased community engagement and becoming more strategic, which has positively impacted the direction of the Council.

Working for FTC has many benefits including automatic enrolment to the Local Government Pension Scheme, an attractive Annual Leave allocation and staff discount for the Café. The Council has a dedicated Personnel Committee made up of Members who ensure that the duty of care towards staff is upheld.

The latest position available within the staff team is for a Catering Assistant. The success of the Rendezvous Café and the in-house catering demands for private hirers of the Rufus Centre, means we need to grow our staff team to continue to provide an exceptional service to our customers.
