1482. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

To receive apologies for absence. Cllr Snape was absent due to annual holiday.

1483. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

1484. CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

No items.

1485. PUBLIC OPEN SESSION

There was no members of the public present.

1486. INVITED SPEAKER

There was no invited speaker.

1487. MEMBERS QUESTIONS

There was no questions from Members.

1488. MINUTES

For Members to receive and adopt the Minutes of the Business I&DB Committee held on **Tuesday 12th September 2023. (This item was moved to exempt)**

1489. MATTERS ARISING

There were no matters arising.

1490. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

The Chairman explained the Members that the order of the agenda would be changed to the following; A, F, C, D, G, B, E.

a. Sharp IT Contract

Members were informed that the current contract was due to expire in May 2024 and the details within the contract needed to be reviewed. Cllrs Harald and Patterson agreed to review this with Officers to ensure it met the requirements of the Council.

The Town Clerk advised that the contract would go to tender in January 2024.

Action: Town Clerk

b. Ticket Solve

Members were advised that currently ticketing for event/activities had been administered via Eventbrite or manually via Officers, however Eventbrite had recently removed access to list events free of charge. The Business & Facilities Manager advised that with a growing events programme for 2024, implementation of a box office system would be beneficial and would reduce officer time and vastly improve the journey for users.

The proposed ticketing system, Ticket Solve, included additional opportunities such as, unlimited number of events, multiple seating layouts, multiple venues, fundraising opportunities at checkout, data capture, upsell/bolt on catering and drink options and more.

Members asked if the booking fee could be increased if required, the Business & Facilities Manager advised that this could be implemented if required. Members also asked if a marketing database could be created off the back of the ticketing system to help promote future events. The Business & Facilities Manager also advised this was possible.

It was **RESOLVED** to proceed with the implementation of Ticket Solve and where necessary subsidise the uplift in shortfall of £5,000 p/a ticket sales.

c. Lockyer Suite Capital Works

Members considered the report from the Business & Facilities Manager. Members were keen to understand what elements of the work would provide an income benefit and suggested Officers identifying this in the report and re- it at the next meeting. Members were keen to carry out all works but phasing it may be a financial necessity.

Action: Business & Facilities Manager

d. Office Space Refurbishment

Members considered the proposal to convert the existing Marketing Office to expand office space for MIND. Members were keen to understand how the Council would gain commitment from MIND if the conversion took place. Members also asked how much annual rental would be received for the room.

The Business & Facilities Manager advised that verbal commitment had been received and a short-term lease of an alternative room had been signed in the interim. The Town Clerk advised that the annual rental income would be approximately £7,500 per annum.

Members suggested a minimum charge of £30 per sq. ft considering the room would be refurbished in addition to the relocation of fire doors.

It was **RESOLVED** to approach MIND regarding the annual rental payment on the proposed office space and request that a signed head of terms or revised lease would be required to show commitment before the Council agree to the works.

e. Business Improvement & Development Board Draft Budget 2024/25

The Chairman explained that a change of internal processes meant that the budget setting for 2024/25 was far more organised and gave Members a better opportunity to scrutinise the figures before setting the overall precept. Members discussed the budget in detail and asked several questions in relation to some of the content. It was agreed for the Senior Finance Officer to make amendments with a revised version being presented to the December meeting.

The Senior Finance Officer explained that 421/1022 (rent receivable tenants) proposed budget would be increased to reflect the letting of additional office space. Members were also advised that staffing had been reviewed across all council functions and had resulted in a reallocation which has a significant impact on business area costs in the proposed budgets for 2024/25. Members requested the combined figures for catering income and related expenditure are presented to the next meeting to allow for comparison to previous years.

f. Forward Capital Plan

Members discussed the forward capital plan and the Chairman explained that the current list included the main currently anticipated projects, as opposed to projects that could be delivered within the next financial year. Members agreed that the plan needed some prioritisation, by officers, so that Members could consider the list and agree what would be achievable in the next few financial years.

Action: Senior Management Team

g. Event Proposal

Members considered the report from the Business & Facilities Manager and raised several questions in relation to the event.

The Chairman felt that it would be better to focus on events that would take place within the Rufus Centre as opposed to large scale events on the field which posed increased risks, including adverse weather etc.

A Member asked if there were any restrictions on using the outside space and the Business & Facilities Manager advised that all outdoor events had to be finished by 9pm.

The Business & Facilities Manager did advised Members that it was the 25th anniversary of the Rufus Centre next year and this could be incorporated into some form of event.

Members asked if event 'cancellation' insurance could be obtained to help mitigate the risks associated with the event. The Town Clerk advised that this could be obtained as event insurance had recently been sourced for the Christmas Lights Events and the Family Fun Day.

It was agreed for the Business & Facilities Manager to revisit the proposal with a scaled down option to include event cancellation insurance.

Prioritised LOCKYER SUITE REMEDIAL UPGRADES

Background

The Lockyer Suite (LS) is currently our premier event space responsible for generating the largest proportion of our events and function revenue. As a result of the high-capacity events and the nature of those events some attendees of The Rufus Centre may only visit The Lockyer Suite. The space itself has been hired approximately 262 times within the last 12 months and the audio-visual equipment has generated approximately £3520.00 in revenue.

This project was originally presented in the draft forward capital plan for 2024-25 to the Finance Working Group & Members suggested this project be considered by BIDB in this financial year.

Introduction

Based on feedback taken from our recently implemented Microsoft Form <https://forms.office.com/e/GHF5NwQTqD> that is issued to the majority of hirers (post event) feedback has been good all round, however our audio visual facilities have consistently scored lower than all other areas of the business (based on 20 + responses to date).

Having worked in several roles within the entertainment industry I concur that our facilities are in urgent need of modernisation. Upgrades will ensure the AV equipment is in line with client expectations and meets the technical demands of our clients, meets the needs of our business and operates to a standard that provides peace of mind to our clients and support staff, particularly those responsible for operating the equipment. As a result of our AV not meeting our current demands added pressure is put onto our Hospitality Porters to ensure that the equipment functions to the best of its ability and looks presentable.




Figure 1- RUFUS FEEDBACK SURVEY

Options

Areas of particular concern include the following:

1. Audio to include radio microphones, sound system and induction loop (quote for £9,650.09)
 - a. Sub let possible at £25 per mic per day, however currently we include them FOC

The above works will include relocation and replacement of our wireless microphone rack (currently situated within the Rendezvous Café and our most comment complaint), upgrade of existing loudspeakers (& replacing with white fixtures) and improving the control of the sound system to include amalgamating the large sound system with our smaller in house sound system thus guarantee improved coverage, audio integrity and a fuller sound. In addition, these works will future proof the sound system for expansion slightly.

2. Video to include ceiling mounted projection and improved access & connections £13,161.42 or £16,419.42
 - a. Currently charged at £40 per day – Increase to £50 per day

Our current large format display projector is set up manually every time projection is required within The Lockyer and as such is time consuming for Hospitality Porters. This system looks unprofessional and in addition carries unnecessary wear and tear on the equipment, running the risk of damage and does not provide peace of mind to both our staff and visitors. The projector should be permanently mounted in a position which negates this. Access plates will be fitted to both the rear and front of the room.

3. Lighting to improved ambient lighting options and improved control - £4,810.00
 - a. Chargeable at approximately £100 per day

The existing theatrical and ambient lighting within the LS is of entry level and does not provide adequate lighting cover for the events taking place within the space. Our humble stock of LED fixtures are both dated and of low wattage. These lighting fixtures will support to enhance conferences, functions and events alike and where necessary can be utilised in other areas of the business. The quotation for these items include:

- 12 Alu HEX Par 64 (12 x 12W 6-in-1 RGBWAUV)
- 12 Combi PowerCON and XLR 3-Pin Male - Female DMX Cable - 3m
- 2 W-DMX Micro F-1 Lite G6 Transceiver
- 2 Colour Raider Lithium Battery 4-Way Uplighter Pack – Black

4. Power to include improved access to 13 Amp socket points - £2488.00

- a. **Not chargeable – These are essential to bring the space in line with demands and requirements.**

The LS is an old school hall offering limited access to floor level sockets or power to the overhead lighting bars meaning when ambient lighting throughout the room is required cabling needs to be run, most often looking unsightly and creating trip hazards (in addition to the labour time for Hospitality Porters). As our venue is multi-purpose it needs to offer the staff and hirers the flexibility to arrange the space safely and effectively in a variety of formats. Estimate will include the addition of:

- 5 x floor level 13A sockets
- 2 x advance bar sockets
- 3 x Floor recessed sockets
- 1 x 13A socket to the raked seating unit
- Replacement of all cable containment throughout (trunking)

5. Stretched fabric cladding to main rear wall - £6,957.85

- a. **Not chargeable – These are essential to bring the space in line with demands and requirements**

The gable end wall adjacent to The Rendezvous Café (shown in Fig2) is again unsightly and being the main focal point of the majority of our conferencing events requires some improvement to ensure that it is in keeping with the standard expected from our clients and the variety of our events. The windows are non operational and serve no purpose and the block work is unappealing. Options include cladding in acoustic panelling or plastering / rendering, but these processes would be wet processes and as such causing considerable mess to the space.

6. Black drapery / curtains to doors & improved blackout blinds to windows £3045.20

- a. **Not chargeable – These are essential to bring the space in line with demands and requirements.**

The soft furnishings within the LS are dated and jarring and in desperate need of modernisation and replacement as the colour scheme is questionable. A number of the windows could have window film vinyl in place of curtains as the blinds are seldom opened and the curtains impact the look of the room and colour choices date rapidly and do not provide the neutral backdrop required for our variety of flexible events from weddings to conferences. <https://camstage.com/curtains-drapes-and-tabs>




Figure 3 - Gable end wall (soft furnishings)

7. NEW LED star cloth - £5,284.00
 - a. Currently charge at £315 per event

As shown in Figure 2 the raked seating unit (when not in use) is stored to the gable end wall and can be found unsightly. Many of our lettings opt to bolt on our star cloth to mask the seating unit, however the star cloth in question is made from an ivory muslin and not suitable for certain styled events. We would like to invest in a black wool serge LED star cloth as an alternative option. As this star cloth is frequently hired as a bolt on to letting costs we will certainly recoup the investment.

Financial opportunities

That is a vast financial incentive to us in the bolt on of audio-visual equipment. Within the last 12 months generating approximately £3520.00 in revenue within The Lockyer Suite alone. Improving our Audio-Visual facilities will allow us to explore additional business opportunities and bring our charges in line with our competitors. There is no direct ROI for this expenditure however it will work to support return trade / repeat bookings and subsequent positive feedback which directly correlates to constructive marketing of our facilities and help to secure a foothold in this competitive market.

To attract new business from the corporate conferencing market our facilities need modernising. Venues such as Centre Parcs have that instant 'wow factor' that our venue should offer.

Additional new business opportunities could include corporate clients (a large majority of our business currently comes via CBC & NHS) and further exploring the venue for amateur dramatics.

Additional matters

We have booked a dark week for the Lockyer Suite for week beginning 01/01/2024 to sand and seal the flooring and during which time some of these works could be completed.

Costs based on the attached quotations are £ 48,654.56 based on current pricings (these may be subject to change)

Officer recommendation

For members to consider allocation £48,654.56 from the Rolling Capital for Lockyer Suite improvements. To agree works for w/c 1/1/24 which can be done alongside the already booked in flooring works (subject to availability).

These works form part of a progressive upgrade of the facilities within The Rufus Centre to bring them in line with our competitors and client expectations and is NOT a full refurbishment of the space. Further work to modernise The Lockyer Suite will be required progressively.

FLIT VALLEY WALK



The Flit Valley walk follows the Flit through its scenic valley rich in history and wildlife. It is a walk in the Greenand Country landscape.

The 7.5 mile route introduces you to some of the wonders to be found along the Flit. From ancient woods to the stone bridge of historic buildings such as Pitwick Mill and Pitwick Manor, and archaeological finds.

The Town Council has been working in partnership with the Greenand Country Landscape Partnership to develop the walk and encourage people to go outdoors and explore the wonderful countryside in the area.

Along one of the route there you will find a trail from Westport to Stone using footpaths on existing rights of way. Here you'll find interpretation boards with information on the local history and flora and fauna you can see. You'll also learn more about the fascinating history of the area.

As you explore the route, you'll also be able to spot some amazing wooden sculptures like the jumping fox in Manor Park, which has been created by Sculpture Artist, Ian Peckham.

Along the way you can visit the Flit Valley Discovery Centre located at just Crawley Memorial Barn, Brook Lane, Pitwick, MK43 3DQ (200m from Flit Valley).

BRANDING REVIEW

DRAFT DESIGN BRIEF

BACKGROUND

Over the last four years the scope of communications and marketing responsibilities has increased to meet growing demand, both for the Council and for commercial activity for The Rufus Centre and The Rendezvous Café & Bar which are both owned and operated by Flitwick Town Council. Each of these has their own brand identity and an increasing range of marketing channels.

Key communication and marketing activities over this period in chronological order have included:

- Redesign of The Rufus Centre website in July 2019.
- Launch of The Rendezvous Café & Bar at The Rufus Centre in August 2020. The Café has a separate section on The Rufus Centre website.
- Redesign of the FTC website in September 2020.
- Refurbishment and investment in The Rufus Centre's facilities in 2020.
- Partial redesign of quarterly magazine, Flitwick Papers in June 2021. The magazine has a print run of 6,300 per issue and is delivered to every household in Flitwick and is available for pick up from key areas in the town i.e., The Rufus Centre and Flitwick Library.
- Relaunch of visual identity for The Hub, offering services for young people in October 2022. The Hub is also used as a regular meeting space for the community and available for hire.
- Launch of the Community Fridge, supporting cost of living initiative and reducing food waste, branded under the national Hubbub umbrella in January 2023.
- Focus on the wider cost of living crisis with the appointment of Community Services Officer dedicated to increase support offered to residents including weekly Community Hub, free movie events and Job Club.
- Launch of PROUD AF – a joint initiative with Ampthill Town Council, which offers a range of new services and events for the LGBTQ+ community and allies with its own visual identity in February 2023.
- Partial launch of Flitwick Living History project – dedicated website to be launched in spring 2024 volunteer led. The project Facebook page is live.
- Increase in the number of social media pages and channels across all areas. (see Marketing Communications Channels attached).

THE BRANDS

Flitwick Town Council

The Town Council has 16 Councillors who volunteer their services to act on behalf of Flitwick residents to improve the local community. This is supported by a small team of officers who deliver agreed projects and services.

The Rufus Centre

The Rufus Centre is a flexible meetings, conference, and events venue, licenced to hold weddings and civil ceremonies. with seven meeting rooms that accommodate up to 200 people. In addition, it is home to Flitwick Town Council, a range of tenants who lease office space, and The Rendezvous Café & Bar.

The Rendezvous Café & Bar

The Rendezvous Café is situated inside the Rufus Centre and prides itself on offering a friendly service in a relaxed setting using locally sourced produce where possible. It has a high percentage of repeat custom and is a popular meeting place for community groups, as well as some business customers. Outside of normal operational hours it is used as a smaller event space, available for hire.

MARKETING ASSETS REVIEW

A review of communications & marketing assets across the three brands was presented to Members at the Corporate Services meeting in September 2022. (See Branding Review attached).

Outcomes agreed at the meeting:

- There is a lack of visibility of FTC branding across the range of assets. Posters in particular include contact sign off at the bottom of page showing the event is organised by FTC, but it does not 'jump out' that it is an FTC event/initiative.
- Lack of FTC association with The Rufus Centre and Rendezvous Café & Bar. It is not clear that both are owned and managed by FTC.
- Lack of consistent approach with a mix of typefaces and graphic styles.
- Basic brand guidelines in place for FTC, The Rufus Centre and Rendezvous Café & Bar are currently restricted to use of logo and one and full colour specifications. The guidelines need to be developed further to include tone of voice, etc.
- Lack of consistency in the presentation of basic Council documentation in the public domain i.e., agendas, minutes, policies.

THE TEAM

The Communications & Marketing Team was reduced in February 2023 to one person, working part time for a total of 33 hours per week.

SOFTWARE USED

All work is currently produced in-house using Canva Pro and InDesign (predominantly for Flitwick Papers). Flitwick Papers has an established template set up on InDesign. Council documentation is produced in Word. Both FTC and The Rufus Centre websites are built with WordPress.

ADDITIONAL POINTS FOR CONSIDERATION

There is no intention to change the FTC website or the anchor colours of teal, grey and black.

The Rufus Centre logo was refreshed in March 2021. However, the introduction of this logo was put on hold.

The mix of visual identities for different FTC projects that show no association with FTC such as The Hub and the Community Fridge.

The wide variety of traditional and digital marketing channels across the three brands and sub-brands (see document attached).

Event tickets are currently sold via Eventbrite. In January 2024 tickets will be sold via ticketing platform Ticketsolve which will give more flexibility, upselling opportunities, CRM, etc.




- How do we effectively position The Rufus Centre and Rendezvous Café & Bar as part of the FTC family?
