Flitwick Town Council (FTC) is a third-tier local Government organisation comprising four departments in the staff team – finance & administration, business, community & amenity services, and marketing & communications. We proactively work on aims set within our strategy and focus on exceptional service provision while owning and managing The Rufus Centre. The venue is a busy meeting, conference, and event destination where the Town Council offices are based.

Another string to our bow is our Rendezvous Café & Bar at The Rufus Centre, which has grown from strength to strength since opening in August 2020.

There are 15 elected Members of the Council who volunteer their time to represent the residents of Flitwick and make key decisions on behalf of the community. Our Members have expertise in various areas, such as finance, business, and the arts, which helps the staff team complete their tasks. Since the elections in 2019, Members have changed many things, such as increased community engagement and becoming more strategic, which has positively impacted the direction of the Council.

Working for FTC has many benefits, including automatic enrolment into a competitive pension scheme, an attractive annual leave allocation, and a staff discount for the Café. The Council has a dedicated HR Committee of Members who upholds the duty of care towards staff.
